Committee Meeting Summary

16th December 2015

Before dealing with committee items Roy thanked Kay for her efforts organising successful Christmas celebrations at all but the Tuesday session. Tuesday was capably managed by Jill Blenkey with able assistance from Sue Foggett and the Roaches. Thanks to everyone for helping and participating.

AGM Issues

One item raised at this year's AGM remained to be answered.

- Event Prize Money
 - Tony's investigation into the query as to why prize money awarded during the 2014/15 calendar year appeared to be lower than the previous year had arisen due to an accounting anomaly. He could show that prize monies awarded for the two years were commensurate, the discrepancy was a book-keeping problem.

Building Maintenance

The next phase on the maintenance schedule was approved to commence at the beginning of February. That work entails minor repairs to the external fabric of the building, installation of a new shed and painting the external surfaces. Committee accepted that brickwork rendering was an unnecessary expense. The work is not expected to affect bridge sessions but member co-operation and support whilst the work proceeds would be appreciated.

Session Attendance

Falling attendance at sessions is still of concern. The introduction on Tuesdays and Fridays of a stand-by player to team up with any player who for whatever reason arrives without a partner has been a great success. Member suggestions on how to encourage increased attendance are still welcomed.

Jeff has made a concerted effort to promote Wayne's next block of bridge lessons. He has arranged to set up an information desk within the Kotara Fair complex on 24th January. He hopes to generate public interest in the game and perhaps to sign up new learners for the lessons.
