4 CARRY-OVER ISSUES:

4.1 *NBC 50th anniversary*:

5 FINANCIAL REPORT:

YTD Table fees are 1.3% higher than last year, but 2.5% below budget.

We will be relying on new members to achieve budgeted subscriptions.

Electricity continues to be favourable – the LED lights have made a significant difference. Printing costs are above budget, mainly due to the purchase of new receipt booklets (not an annual purchase).

All other variations as previously reported.

Expected profit is approx. \$3500 less than budget (NB the full budget has not yet been revised – TW will aim to do this for the April meeting).

KW moved that the Financial Reports be accepted; JB seconded the motion.

6 NEW BUSINESS:

6.1 Thursday Night Bridge:

Due to poor attendance, there has been no Thursday night Bridge for 3 weeks. Alison Lea has been doing her best to keep it going by phoning players but has not been successful. It was agreed to cancel it immediately. Alison was contacted during the meeting and she agreed to let the usual players know. It was agreed to move qualifier events previously scheduled for Thursday night to Monday night (GNOT, Country Teams, State Pairs, red point events).
