ABF Bushfire Fund Raising

ABF will waive masterpoint fees for Clubs that hold fundraising events to support victims of the bushfires. In the past we have taken the view that members will make their own decisions about donations to disaster appeals. We have therefore decided not to participate.

CARRY-OVER ITEMS

Beginners lessons

Only 4 people have registered so far for the lessons (due to start 3rd February). Promotion has been by announcements before Bridge sessions, flyers left at shopping centres and other locations, and Facebook. An email has been sent to members asking for their help to spread the word. We will also approach local MP's to suggest they promote the lessons in their newsletters.

Handicap Prize System for 3-week Pairs Events

It was agreed that the handicap prize for 3-week Pairs will be awarded to the pair with the highest aggregate percentage (over the 3 sessions based on Match Points) AND who both have a handicap of less than 50%. The change will be implemented for the first 3-week event of 2020 (February Pairs both Monday sessions starting 3rd February). An email has been sent to members.

FINANCE

Tony advised that he had found some errors in the budget figures and has adjusted the November to June figures accordingly. Reporting will be against these figures for the balance of the year. The revision, inclusive of the unbudgeted \$5750 spend to replace the kitchen bench, shows a surplus of \$6654 for the full year.

Table fee revenue is now close to YTD budget and 7.4% above last year. Expenses for the first half were in line with budget overall and 4.2% higher than last year. Insurances are now due.

NEW BUSINESS

Rookie Row - Wednesday session

A "Rookie Row", restricted to players with up to 20 Masterpoints, will be trialled for 2 months on the Wednesday session, starting 4th March. Stand-by volunteer players are being sought so that members without a partner can participate. The trial will be terminated if it fails to attract less than 4 tables.
